You have an appointment at the Center for Urogynecology with \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ am / pm. This appointment will be in our Bethlehem office at 1770 Bathgate Road. Urogynecology and Continence Management is a subspecialty of gynecology that addresses those patients with bladder problems, pelvic organ prolapse, and pelvic pain. At this appointment, you will undergo an evaluation. The doctor will then discuss the findings and possible treatment options available to you.

**If you are coming in for a Urogynecology problem visit**, please complete the following forms to the best of your ability. **Please complete these forms PRIOR to your arrival at the office.** Enclosed you will find:

1. **New Patient History & Physical**, 2 pages, you should fill this out as thoroughly as possible up to “Physician Section” on page 2, every question asked is pertinent in getting an accurate diagnosis. Even if you feel it does not apply to your particular problem, please complete this.
2. **Pelvic Pain and Urgency/Frequency symptom scale**, 1 page, answer all questions.
3. **Patient Information**, 1 page, read, please complete all information, and sign bottom of form.
4. **Communication Permission**, 1 page, read and complete. This is important for the nurses to be able to know what phone numbers they may use to contact you.
5. **Voiding Diary**. Please record 3 days of bladder habits. Not consecutive days.
6. **LVPG Consent for Treatment**. Please sign and date the bottom of form.
7. **Medication Log** - Please complete the enclosed medication log, **being sure to include ALL medications (prescription or over-the-counter), vitamins, minerals and herbal supplements that you may take – EVEN IF THEY ARE ONLY TAKEN OCCASIONALLY**. Certain types of medications, whether prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins and herbal supplements, can cause your blood to thin, so it is important to let our doctor and nurse know what is being taken. Examples of medications which may thin the blood are as follows:
  - a. **Aspirin products or Salicylates**
  - b. **Prescription pain meds** – such as Mobic, Duragesic, and Migraine Meds
  - c. **Over-the-Counter pain meds** – such as Ibuprofen, Motrin, Ecotrin, Advil and Aleve
  - d. **Prescription meds** – such as Coumadin, Heparin, Plavix, Trental and Vanquish
  - e. **Vitamins, minerals and herbals** – such as Vitamin E, Fish Oil, Omega-3, and Garlic

- f. **Over-the Counter and Prescription Cold and Allergy medications**
- g. **Pepto-Bismol**

**If you are coming in for a GYNECOLOGY visit**, you will only need to complete the New Patient H&P, Communication Permission, Consent for Treatment, Medication log, and Patient Information form.

**You must bring all completed forms, as well as your current insurance cards, with you to your first appointment.** The paperwork sent to you is important to aid in your diagnosis. **We ask that you arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment.** If you are late, your appointment may need to be rescheduled. If you have questions prior to your appointment, please contact our office by calling our **office at 484-884-8840**. We will be happy to assist you with any questions or concerns.

Please contact your primary care physician to see if a referral is needed for your visit.
